



Official Rules for OctoberFEAST Cornhole Tournament

COIN TOSS

- The coin toss winner will decide if they want to throw first and also chooses bag color OR chooses the side of the board they want to throw from for the game.

TEAMS

- Team A competes against Team B - each team is comprised of two (2) people
- Each team will stay in their designated lane for the entire game
- Players at the headboards will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all four (4) of his/her bags

SCORE

- Winning score is 21 or high score at 20-minute mark. If the 20-minute time limit is called during a round, both teams will be allowed to finish the round
- If you score over 21, your score will be set to 15
- Tie-breaker will be determined on site

POINTS

- Woody: Each woody is worth one (1) point. If the bag is hanging off the board, the board will be lifted. If the bag stays on the board, it counts. If the bag falls off, no point is awarded
- Cornhole: Each cornhole is worth three (3) points
 - Example:
 - Black achieves one (1) woody and two (2) cornholes during the frame (7 total points)
 - Blue achieves two (2) woodies and zero (0) cornholes during the frame (2 points)
 - 7 points minus 5 points = Black scores 5 points for that frame
- Winning team is to report the win to the registration table

PITCHING

- Players alternate pitching bags (one player at a time) until each player has pitched all four (4) of his/her bags
- A player must pitch all four (4) cornhole bags from their designated side behind the box. Players cannot step past the front of the board
- Players must deliver the bag with an underhand release
- When pitching a bag, players must release the bag before any part of the player's body touches the ground in front of the board
- The player/team who scored in the preceding frame shall pitch first in the next frame. If neither player/team scores, the player/team who pitched first in the preceding frame shall retain first pitch in the next frame
- The toss will not count if the bag bounces before it lands on the board or goes in the hole

OFFICIAL RULING

- If there are any questions on ruling, the official time keeper's ruling stands
